






MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTORATE OF THE DA

The academic curriculum in the five study disciplines - political science and international relations, international economics, international and European law, contemporary history and cultural studies - is the cornerstone of all programmes at the DA.

The DA is an affiliate member of APSIA (Association of Professional Schools of International Affairs) and a member of UNAI (United Nations Academic Impact). In addition, the European Commission has awarded the DA with the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) for the 2021-2027 period of the Erasmus+ Programme.

The DA is an autonomous institution of higher education established under Austrian public law. The statutory organs of the Vienna School of International Studies comprise the Board of Trustees, the Academic Board and the Director.
