EXECUTIVE TRAINING PROGRAMMES/ETPs

European and International Affairs

The DA organises a broad range of training courses for public officials and junior diplomats from Southeast Europe, the Black Sea region/South Caucasus and ACP countries. These two to four-week programmes familiarise participants with the European Union as well as with important issues in international politics (e.g. the UN "Sustainable Development Goals"). The training courses are organised in cooperation with the Austrian Foreign Ministry and funded by the Austrian Development Cooperation.

The ETPs cover a broad range of academic analyses, critical discussions and the training of soft and practical skills. In interactive exercises, participants are encouraged to sharpen their analytical capabilities, management and negotiation skills, as well as crisis management and conflict resolution strategies. Study visits to the headquarters of Vienna-based international organisations as well as to European institutions in Brussels and The Hague provide participants with a first-hand insight into the working of these institutions.

The DA also provides advanced training modules for Austrian diplomats.

Female Leadership

In order to promote women as leaders, the DA designs training programmes for women working for governments, international organisations or the private sector, and students from around the world. These courses focus on the strengthening of skills like leadership or mediation and highlight issues related to the empowerment of women and girls.



TAILOR-MADE PROGRAMMES – SEMINARS, MODULES AND WORKSHOPS

The DA organises short- and long-term tailor-made trainings on various topics for governmental and non-governmental institutions, companies and universities in Vienna and abroad.

In-Depth Knowledge and Practical Skills

The DA's vast network of international and national experts enables the DA

- I to create comprehensive and manifold programmes
- I to impart detailed theoretical knowledge on International and European Affairs and specific selected policy areas
- to allow for in-depth insights into diplomatic practice via study visits and encounters with practitioners
- I to offer simulations and interactive workshops that equip participants with useful practical skills pertinent to their professional careers

The global community is facing a number of urgent and complex challenges, for example climate change or combatting infectious diseases. The tackling of these issues requires close collaboration between diplomats and scientists. The DA is a consortium member of the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation project "S4D4C – Using science for/in diplomacy for addressing global challenges". S4D4C supports science diplomacy in the EU for the benefit of the Union's strategic capacities, stimulates the development of efficient science policy interfaces and offers training for science diplomats.

S4D4C - USING SCIENCE FOR/IN DIPLOMACY FOR ADDRESSING GLOBAL CHALLENGES

The DA's S4D4C-project partners are universities and institutions from eight European countries such as the Centre for Social Innovation (ZSI), Charles University Prague (CU), the German Aerospace Centre, the Project Management Agency

(DLR), German Centre for Science Studies and Higher Education Research (DZHW), the Spanish Foundation for Science and Technology (FECYT), the World Academy of Sciences (TWAS), the University of Lille (ULille), the University of Sheffield (USFD), and the University of Twente (UT).

The DA's tailor-made courses on science diplomacy are based on case studies, best practices and relevant research. They equip participants with knowledge and know-how about the intersection of science, technology and foreign policy aiming at more productive and sustainable international relations at multilateral and bilateral levels. The DA stands ready to offer these trainings and further science-diplomacy-related programmes to interested institutions.

PERFORMING IN EUROPE: EU COUNCIL PRESIDENCY TRAINING, EUROPEAN DIPLOMATIC TRAINING

The DA provides specialised training programmes for public officials and diplomats from EU-member states in preparation of their EU-Council Presidencies. These modules include seminars on EU institutions and EU decision-making processes as well as interactive trainings on negotiation, presentation and chairing techniques. In addition, the DA carries out trainings on protocol, international event and delegation management as well as seminars on the effective use of press, PR and Social

Media techniques in a European context. EU related language trainings are also available.

The DA also offers courses within the framework of the European Diplomatic Programme, a common training programme for foreign service officials from all EU member states, the European External Action Service, the European Commission and the General Secretariat of the Council.

SUMMER SCHOOLS AND ACADEMIC COOPERATION PROGRAMMES

Inter-University Summer School on European Policy Making (Diplomatische Akademie Wien – Vienna School of International Studies, Institute for European Studies at Vrije Universiteit Brussel, University of Vienna)

Since 2014 the DA, the Institute for European Studies (IES), and the University of Vienna have jointly organised the inter-university Summer School on EU Policy-making. These two-week programmes are held in Brussels (first week) and Vienna (second week) and are geared towards international students and young professionals who have a background in European studies, political science, history, law or economics, as well as junior professionals and EU practitioners who wish to broaden their knowledge of the EU.

Each edition of the Summer School focuses on a pressing policy issue (e.g. Security in the EU) and combines lectures on EU institutions and decision–making procedures with study visits

and simulation games; numerous extra-curricular leisure and networking activities round off the programme.

Summer School for the European Studies Institute/ MGIMO University, Moscow

The DA organises a week-long tailor-made Summer School for students of the European Studies Institute at the Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MGIMO University). The Summer School (a Jean Monnet project) is centred on common topics of interest to both the European Union and Russia, and consists of a theoretical introduction followed by a practice-oriented skills training.

Participants can better grasp the global relevance of the topics discussed during these Summer Schools through study visits to international organisations in Vienna.



Summer Course for German Language and Austrian Studies

Summer Courses for German Language and Austrian Studies are organised by the DA in August and offer four weeks of intensive German classes for learners of all levels. They are suited for students, diplomats and their spouses, as well as interested participants from other professional fields. Candidates 18 and over can participate in this programme.

International Experience at the DA Campus

Summer Course participants come from all over the world and enjoy the vibrant international spirit and multiculturalism of the DA Campus. The DA, located in a former Imperial Palace in the centre of Vienna, provides a great environment for study and exchange. The Academy offers participants guest rooms on its premises and a beautiful private garden.

Experienced Trainers and State-of-the-Art Methodology

The Summer Course team consists of highly qualified teachers with long-standing expertise in teaching German as a Foreign Language to adults. Participants benefit not only from the latest methodological and didactic insights of linguistics, but from highly practice-related course materials. Teaching in small groups facilitates the accommodation of individual needs and requests, including preparation for internationally recognised language certificates.

Course Programme: Lectures, Excursions and Leisure Activities

Four-hour language training classes in the morning are followed by additional in-depth lectures, excursions and a range of leisure activities in the afternoon, depending on the course options chosen by candidates. Special lectures cover various aspects of Austrian politics, history, economics, and culture. Study visits to international organisations based in Vienna illustrate the global standing of the city. Moreover, participants explore the beauty of the Austrian countryside through daytrips to picturesque destinations outside of Vienna. A hike through vineyards, wine tasting, and many more fun activities complete the rich programme. Last but not least, dance classes teach participants how to waltz like the Viennese.

Exploring the many facets of Vienna

"City research projects" encourage participants to deepen their knowledge of the many facets of the Austrian capital. They also encourage them to put their German language skills acquired in the classroom into practice.





Le DFP RI (Diplôme de français professionnel des Relations internationales) a été créé à la demande du Ministère français des Affaires étrangères et du Développement international et de l'Organisation internationale de la Francophonie. Ces deux institutions soutiennent l'usage de la langue française au sein des organisations internationales et dans les échanges politiques et diplomatiques à l'international.

Ce diplôme est issu de la collaboration entre le Centre de Langue Française de la CCI Paris Ile-de-France, spécialiste depuis plus de 50 ans des diplômes professionnels et de l'équipe pédagogique du département de Français de la DA, l'École des Hautes Études Internationales de Vienne.

Le DFP RI est un diplôme professionnalisant, offrant des certifications du niveau B1 à C1. Il atteste de la capacité d'un professionnel dans le secteur des relations internationales et de la diplomatie à travailler en français : comprendre et produire des écrits spécifiques à ce secteur, avec le lexique approprié, comprendre et interagir à l'oral avec ses homologues et interlocuteurs. Le diplôme est internationalement reconnu et valable à vie.

L'ÉQUIPE ENSEIGNANTE ET MÉTHODOLOGIE

L'Académie dispose d'une équipe de professeurs de langue maternelle française hautement qualifiés et expérimentés possédant une formation spécifique pour l'enseignement du français des relations internationales et de la diplomatie.

Les Diplômes de français professionnel s'appuient sur la méthodologie du français sur objectif spécifique (FOS), dont l'objectif est précis et spécifique, se rattachant à des tâches et activités d'un domaine professionnel identifié, sur la base de documents et supports authentiques.

L'enseignement est dispensé en petits groupes. L'équipe pédagogique est soucieuse de répondre aux attentes et besoins de chaque participant.

PROGRAMME DES COURS ET VISITES D'ÉTUDE

Semaine en Français des relations internationales et préparation au DFP RI (diplôme de français professionnel en relations internationales) aux niveaux B1, B2 et C1. Cinq heures de cours par jour. Les après-midis sont consacrés à l'approfondissement de certaines compétences langagières et de visites d'études.

Les participants peuvent également découvrir les organisations internationales qui ont leur siège à Vienne, de même que les institutions autrichiennes et d'en rencontrer les représentants.

EXAMEN

L'examen se passera à la fin de la semaine intensive de préparation. Les activités écrites sont faites sur ordinateur. Les activités orales sont enregistrées sur une tablette numérique.
